Your employees could be eligible for a subsidy of up to £4,065* towards the cost of a Level 3 or Level 4 course if your business is in one of these sectors:

Digital and IT

Engineering

Construction

Business and professional services

Eligibility

If your employees are aged 19+ and live in the West Midlands they could be eligible for a subsidy towards the cost of a course.

^{*} The Career Learning Pilot provides subsidies towards Level 3 & 4 courses. These vary dependent on individual courses. A travel subsidy may also be available depending on eligibility.
