# Skills Bootcamp transition for 2024/2025 to 2025/2026 and Closing-down Bootcamps


### 2024/2025 TO 2025/2026 TRANSITION - Wave 5 Bootcamps

As Wave 5 Bootcamps have until 30<sup>th</sup> September 2025 to claim any outstanding Milestone's 2 or 3 claims - depending on when the 6-month duration ends, eligible Providers may have some learners who started in the 2024/2025 academic year and will need to be imported into the 2025/2026 academic year.


To ensure that their information is in the 2025/2026 version of the Learner Entry tool. Providers will need to import data from the 2024/2025 Learner Entry tool into the 2025/2026 version. Only claims for Milestones dated in August or September 2025, will need to be in the 2025/2026 data. Anything dated earlier should be in the R13 or R14 data for 2024/2025

Following the R12 2024/2025 submission in August 2025, Providers will have the latest version of their XML for Wave 5 Bootcamps.

The 2025/2026 Learner Entry tool needs to be downloaded and opened on the homepage:



Click on the Import Data option, which will prompt a new screen to show:



You will then need to navigate to where the XML for the R12 submission of 2024/2025 is saved and click on that file and then click open.

The data will then be imported into the 2025/2026 version.

Only learners who have the potential for outstanding Milestone 2 or Milestone 3 claims will be imported. For example, if a learner started a Bootcamp in February 2025 and Milestone 2 and 3 have been claimed, this learner will not be in the 2025/2026 version as no further recording is required.

If a learner started a Bootcamp in March 2025 and only Milestone 1 has been claimed, then their record will have been imported into the 2025/2026 version.

The normal recording process for Wave 5 Bootcamps should then be completed in the 2025/2026 year.


It is the Provider's responsibility to ensure that all relevant learners have been imported into the 2025/2026 version. We recommend that you check the data following import, compared with your R12 Skills Bootcamps Devolved occupancy report.

#### Bootcamps who have passed the 6-month duration eligibility

Where the 6-month time period has passed, the Bootcamp will need to be closed down. For some Providers this will be relevant for both 2024/2025 and 2025/2026 data, depending on when their Bootcamps started delivery.


If the component learning aim is recorded as completed and no event has taken place, after six months (six months after the Learning actual end date of the component learning aim) record the programme aim as Completion Status = 2 'The learner has completed the learning activities leading to the learning aim', record Outcome = 3 'No achievement'.

#### Component learning aim:



Against the component learning aim, record Completion Status = 2 'The learner has completed the learning activities leading to the learning aim' and Outcome = 1 or 3 'Achieved' or 'Not Achieved' in the Outcome field.

#### Programme aim:



In the visual examples above, the Bootcamp started on 02/01/2025, with a planned end date of 21/03/2025. The 6-month timeframe for all outcomes to be claimed is 21/09/2025

On the 22/09/2025 no Milestone 2 or 3 has been claimed and the 6-month period has now passed.

The Programme aim of the Bootcamp has an actual end date of 22/09/2025.

If a Milestone 2 has been claimed but no Milestone 3, the same process would be followed.

Closed down Bootcamps can be re-opened where unexpected outcomes are evidenced. These have to be in line with the ILR timeframes, so no later than the R14 submission for 2023/2024 dated outcomes or the R03 submission for 2025/2026 dated outcomes (August and September 2025)

Where a learner has achieved Milestone 3, apart from the destination recording, where not already recorded, nothing further has to be recorded.
